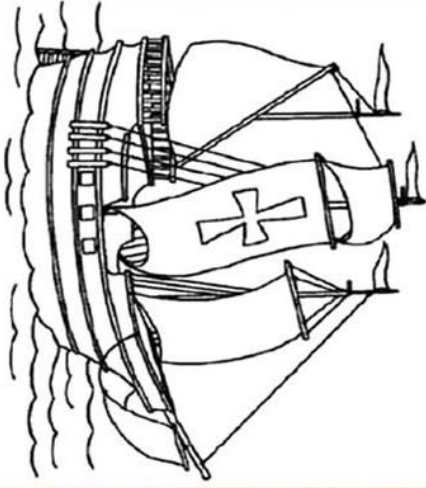


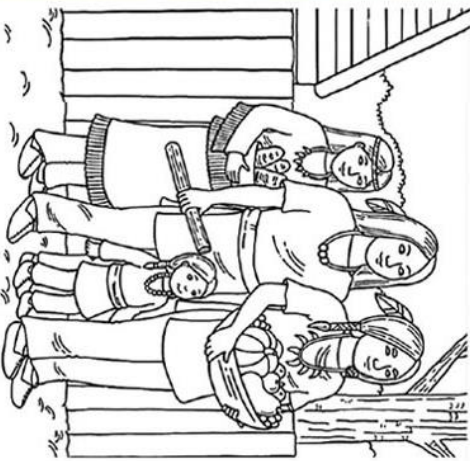
Long ago, people called pilgrims, left their house in England and crossed the ocean on a ship called Mayflower.
